



Covid -19 Measures at Society Meetings

Due to Covid-19 guidelines issued by the Government there will be some changes to the way we handle face to face meetings of the Society.

Our venue at the Mechanics Institute has been busy ensuring measures are in place to keep everyone safe – cleaning is carried out regularly and frequent wiping of door handles, lift buttons etc. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building including at the entrance.

So, to the new 'rules' –

- Do **NOT** attend if you are feeling ill (whether Covid-19 related or not)
- Do **NOT** attend if you have been in contact with anyone with symptoms of Covid-19 or have been ill.
- Wearing of face masks is optional
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the meeting.
- Tea or coffee will be served before the meeting starts. There may be leaflets or booklets to browse.
- Zoom meetings will be available for most of our meeting. See the website for more information and 'Booking for a Zoom Meeting'.

Please be advised that these changes may in themselves change as Government guidelines are eased or further restricted as necessary.
