Who we are?

Bradford Family History Society was founded in 1982 and is an independent organisation run by volunteers who are elected at its Annual General Meeting. It is committed to promoting Family History by education, mutual assistance, demonstrations, lectures, excursions and any other means conducive to its advancement. The Society has members in the UK, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, North America and Europe.

The Society is a member of the Federation of Family History Societies (FFHS) and The Yorkshire Group of Family History Societies.

Policy

It is the policy of the Bradford Family History Society that all events and meetings are open to all including children, young persons and or vulnerable adults.

However, whenever children or young persons under 18 years of age or vulnerable adults attend a meeting, they must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult (over 18 years). This adult to be a parent, guardian or carer.

The said child, young person or vulnerable adult must not be left in a potential one-to-one situation unless the parent, guardian or carer is present with them. This is to protect both children, young persons or vulnerable adults as well as other adults.
